2005 G.R.A.C.E. AWARDS

For the fifth year, Rescue A Golden of Arizona is sponsoring the G.R.A.C.E. (Golden Rescue and Community Excellence) Awards. The Awards were created in honor of a RAGofAZ Rescue dog named **Grace**, who maintained her Golden dignity and sweet personality, despite years of abuse, neglect and then abandonment. The 2005 G.R.A.C.E. Awards will be presented immediately following the National Parade of Rescue Golden. To be eligible, a dog must be a **rescued** Golden; previous winners may not apply. The award categories are: Heroism, Animal Assisted Therapy or Service, Education and Law Enforcement. One dog among all entries will be chosen as Outstanding Rescued Golden of 2005. Golden may be nominated by anyone, including their owners.
